

❖ BASIC RULES FOR SAFETY ON THE ROAD

Service your car regularly – make sure your car is always in a technically proper condition (check your tyres, oil level in the engine, cooling liquid, brakes etc.)

Before starting a trip check the road conditions and the weather forecast.

Drive according to the speed limits – never be fooled by the false feeling of safety. Be careful and often check your speed because you are mostly not aware of the driving speed and the braking time in the case of an accident

Keep the space between cars - don't forget that a higher speed demands also a bigger space between cars because the braking time is reduced the closer you are driving to another car.

In a case of a car defect or an accident – as soon as possible pull over to the side or the stopping track. Wear a safety fluorescent waistcoat and get out of the car so that you don't stand on the track. Set the safety triangle and stand back from the car in order to be as far as possible from the traffic track.

In case you take medication that cause sleepiness or reduce your ability to react, **don't drive!**

During longer travels stop the car on a rest area and take a break every two hours

Help drivers who join the motorway

Don't overload your car – don't put things under your back windscreen because it blocks your view.

TIGHTEN YOUR SEAT BELT! – tightening your seat belt is law bidding as for the driver so for the passengers in the car.
